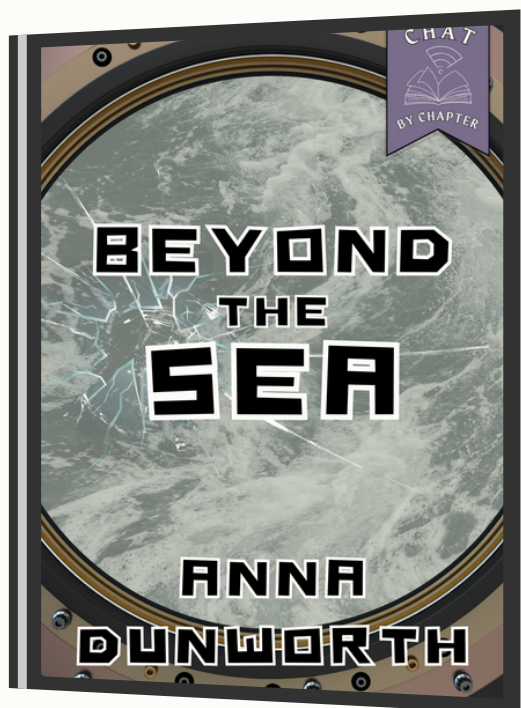


BEYOND THE SEA
